AMENDMENT OF THE EXAMINATION REGULATIONS

A: INTRODUCTION

The Institute's Governing Council has approved amendment of Regulation 23.3 in the current Examination Regulations as revised in 2013. The cited regulation guides assessment for master programmes.

B: PARTICULARS OF AMMENDMENT

Table 1: Particulars of Amendment

Regulation Number	Old Provision	Approved Provision
23.3	<i>A Masters Degree shall be classified as either “Pass” or “Fail”. The award of the Masters Degree shall be made to the successful graduates who have completed and passed all required modules in the taught part and the dissertation. A student who fails to complete the dissertation in the allocated time after re-submission shall be awarded a Postgraduate Diploma</i>	<i>A Masters Degree shall be classified as PASS, MERIT and DISTINCTION based on the average score. The boundaries for this average should 50% to 59% for a pass, 60% to 69% for a merit and 70% to 100% for a distinction. The award of the Masters Degree shall be made to the successful graduates who have completed and passed all required modules in the taught part and the dissertation. A student who fails to complete the dissertation in the allocated time after re-submission shall be awarded a Postgraduate Diploma</i>
