### Submission Guidelines:

**Structured Abstract:** The maximum length of the abstract should be 250 words. The structured abstract should have the following headings:

*Purpose:* Present the purpose of the study.

*Approach/Methodology/Design:* Present the methodology adopted in the study.

*Findings:* Present and highlight the key findings of the study.

*Practical implications:* Explain briefly the practical implications of the study.

*Originality:* Describe the gaps the study aims to fill.

*Keywords:* Appropriate five (5) short keywords of the study.

**Article length:** An article should be submitted in Microsoft Word and should not exceed 8,000 word-limit, including references and appendices.

**Title:** A title page should be submitted separately. It should include a clear title, author's/authors' name(s) and their affiliations, and the corresponding author's contacts. Authors should not include their names anywhere inside the text of the article.

**References:** References must be in APA style.
