The programme intends to produce professionals who will be able to apply skills in a broad range of complex managerial and technical activities related to social protection policies and practices, while exhibiting a high degree of personal and social responsibility to help promote the wellbeing of individuals and society at large. The programme consists of two semesters of total 17 weeks each, with a Dissertation writing process of 12 weeks. **Application is open from March to July, 2017.**
