Health care costs are escalating rapidly in many countries. While many factors contribute to rising costs, health insurance plays a part by shielding patients and physicians from the real cost. - The need for Health Insurance for the informal sector (Up to 1 page)

2.2. Description of the case studies

- A comprehensive description of the selected countries healthcare system. (Here you can create a matrix for comparison, use figures and tables, etc. (Up to 4 pages)

CHAPTER 3: THE PROGRAMME DESIGN (up to 4 pages only)
