- **Taxation:** Innovations for tax compliance, administration, or policy design.
- Management Science: Methods for optimizing organizational decisionmaking and resource allocation.
- Computer Science and Information Technology: Al, blockchain, or data analytics, cyber security solutions for the financial sector.
- Actuarial Science and Mathematics: Advanced models for risk management and financial forecasting.

Problem Statement: Maximum 150 words

- What is the problem your project addresses?
- What is already known about this problem?

Proposed Solution: Maximum 300 words

- Present a solution.
- Outline your project approach in greater detail.
- Defining your project deliverables

Potential Impact: Maximum 200 words

Show the impact of your innovation project on your target audience and organization.

Implementation Plan: Maximum 250 words

- Indicate any budget items you need to deliver the project here.
- Explain why you need specific resources for your project.
- Include an overview of your resource allocation plan outlining where you plan to use the specific resources you need.

- Showcase Your Talent: Present your ideas to a panel of experts and mentors.
- Win Prizes: Compete for prizes.
- Gain Recognition: Get featured on the IFM website and social media.
- Access Resources: Receive mentorship, feedback, and resources to develop your idea further.

Feasibility: Solutions that are practical and achievable with clear steps	30
Presentation: Clear and compelling communication of your idea	15
